





#### Eligibility for MBA (ABM)

Bachelor's degree in agriculture or allied fields from any agricultural university or institution recognized by ICAR/UGC with minimum 60% (55% marks for SC/ST/OBC). Candidates with the latest scorecard of the national level management entrance exam (i.e. CAT, CMAT, MAT, etc.) will be considered for admission as per the institution's eligibility criteria. The age limit is below 30 years. There is no age limit for in-service candidates but they must be sponsored by any industry (registered under Companies Act,1956)/NRI(settled foreign in countries).

#### Eligibility for Ph.D. (ABM)

Eligibility: A Post Graduate degree in Agri Business Management or Degree Master's in **Business** Administration from a ICAR/UGC recognized university with at least 6.5/ 10.0 OGPA (or its equivalent percentage of marks i.e. 65) or equivalent programmes are eligible for admission (6.0 OGPA or 60 per for SC/ST/OBC cent marks candidates.

# Seat Matrix & Selection Process





#### MBA (Agri Business Management) 25<sup>th</sup> Batch (2024-25)

Number of Seats: 44 seats (39 regular, 5 payment)

60% seats are reserved for students of Rajasthan domicile.

Additional 5 seats are reserved for Inservice (no age limit) candidates.

Foreign students may be considered for admission on the basis of nomination from ICAR/Govt. of India on supernumerary seats (02).

In addition, 16 seats are filled by ICAR candidates through ICAR AIEEA-PG examination.

#### **Selection Process**

Candidates are shortlisted based on performance in qualifying tests [For MBA- CAT/CMAT/MAT etc. A qualifying test is not required for inservice candidates sponsored by industry/NRI. For Ph.D.- A written test (PAT) is conducted by IABM, Bikaner], past academic performances, and performance in group discussion & personal interview.

#### Ph.D. (Agri Business Management) 14<sup>th</sup> Batch (2024-25)

Number of Seats: 4 seats 2 [Regular(UR)] + 2[Payment seats(UR)]

Addiditional 1 seat is filled by ICAR candidate through ICAR AICE-SRF (Ph.D.) examination.

#### **Selection Criteria**

For MBA- Admission is based on weighted average of academic performance in X, XII, weighted score of national level entrance examination, GD and PI with a weightage of 10, 10, 30, 20 and 30 respectively. Candidate must have the latest score of any national level entrance examination for management like CAT, MAT, CMAT, etc.

For Ph.D.- 50%, 10%, 15%, 10%, 15% weightage is given to PAT, UG, PG, GD, & PI respectively.
